Amenities Committee Tuesday 13 March 2017 Minutes

Attendees: Cllrs Thompson, Allaway Martin, E Elsmore, C Elsmore, & Penny

Cllr Lusty arrived at 6.35 pm

Cllr Holloway arrived at 6.59 pm

Cllr Thompson took the chair in Cllr Lusty absence

1. Apologies were noted from Cllr Cox

2. There were no declarations of interest on items on the agenda

3. There were no dispensation requests

4. The minutes of 13 February 2018 were noted

The Clerk reported that the planning application for the artwork was about to be submitted

Cllr Lusty took the Chair

5. To make recommendation re the requests from CTFC re King Georg V Recreation ground & pavilion

Recommendation

After some discussion it was agreed that

CTFC should be allowed to provide a moveable darts board

CTFC could alter the height of the kitchen barrier and insert a 1' breakfast bar along the wall

The storeroom should be split in 2 and an additional entrance installed from the kitchen
That all the works should be done at CFTC expense on the agreement that all works carried out pass to the ownership of the Town Council.

The offer is made to CTFC they take out an alcohol licence for the property. That this is under strict conditions of the Council

That whatever the licencing authority determine for the sale of alcohol that CTFC can only sale alcohol on a Saturday when a game or practice is in progress and until 7.30 pm. If any variation to this for a specific event permission from the Town Council must be sought. CTFC must comply with all licencing requirements. The Town Council will reserve the right to withdraw permission for the licence should any of the conditions be broken or if complaints are received from neighbours and or other users.

A letter setting out all conditions to be sent to CTFC

That a condition of hire for the KGV remains as no alcohol sales unless permission is sought from the Council and CTFC

That the cost of a notice board to be erected at the entrance to the field is investigated so that the hire of the facility is publicised.

6. To make recommendation re the installation of bells into the Clock Tower

Recommendation

That this matter is not pursued as the Council do not have the budget for a structural survey or any additional works to the Clock tower

7. To make recommendation re the grit bin audit.

Recommendation

That the sites of all grit bins are recorded

That all councillors are allocated a section of the parish to survey



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The results are recoded on a large map
This is brought to the May Public Safety Committee meeting

8. To have an update on the tree works in the parish.

The Clerk reported that both contractors for the cemetery and Old Station Way had confirmed that the works were scheduled and invoices would be supplied in this financial year. The cemetery ground was very wet and this was preventing the start of the works. Cllr Lusty will keep an eye on the cemetery works.
