- 1. Apologies were noted from Cllrs Whittington, Ball, Holloway & Drury
- 2. There were no declarations of interest on items on the agenda
- 3. There were no dispensation requests
 - The minutes of 19 July 16 were noted Recommendation That the cleaning of the parish benches is undertaken straight away
 - 5. **To have an update on the facilities diary** The diary is up to date. The Clerk was asked to remind the contractor to clean the Clock Tower of the guano before the services of the town clock in November
 - 6. To make recommendation re the repair works required on the Clock Tower Cllr Thompson is to provide the Clerk with the schedule of works
 - 7. To make recommendation re the placement of a bench and floral display in the town centre

Recommendation
