- 2. Cllr Elsmore declared a personal interest in item 10 phone boxes

5. To minutes of 11 February 2020 were noted

6. To make recommendation re LEMP work for wide open green spaces

The Clerk reported that the work was well undertake and the schedules should be with the Council within the next week or two.

7. To progress planned meeting with Plantlife and Forestry Commission re tree planting

The Clerk reported that this matter was being pursued

8. To make recommendation re the topple testing in the cemetery

It was noted that the results of the testing in the old part of the cemetery could not be recorded as the grave were unidentifiable and the historic problems re the mapping of this part of the cemetery **Recommendation**

that the Clerk records that the old part of the cemetery sections A B C D have been toppled tested and all dangerous stones identified and laid low.

That Sections A B C & D are toppled tested in the late spring of this year.

That topple testing training is arranged for new councillors

That the clerk develops a rota for the topple testing programme. (It was noted that the pre letters could not be sent as no up to date records existed of grave owners however signage would be erected in the cemetery)

9. Youth Engagement

There was a discussion re the proposals from the PCSO regarding a series of events to be held at the Bells Field for the youth

Recommendation

That the 3 events planned for May and August are financed to a cost of £1475.00 which includes the purchase of equipment.
