Landscape

- The schedule of incomplete works is scheduled for completion on 28 February 19
- Options will be available then if the work are not completed of either issuing an instruction for the works to be completed within 7 days or to retain the retention monies and complete the works in house.

6. To receive an update regarding documented checks against CTC requirements and LEMP items

The Clerk reported that this was ongoing. The contractor will supply a monthly spreadsheet itemising all safety checks. It was also reported that the Health and Safety file was still incomplete.

7. To agree the next steps regarding adjustments to floodlights and CCTV cameras It was reported that the report from the lighting provider had confirmed that the flood lights had been installed as per the specification and were within the specified light lamination limits. However it was agreed that the light penetration into the neighbouring property was high and could be rectified by tilting the lights by 5° without compromising the lighting of the area. A quote from the landscape contractor for the work seemed high It was proposed that a cost is obtained from a local source stressing that it would need to be completed in the dark and should the costs be more acceptable the work completed
