1. Cllr Lusty was elected as Chair
 2. There were no apologies
 3. There were no declarations of interest on items on the agenda
 4. There were no dispensation requests
 5. The minutes of 9 April 2019 were noted
The clerk reported that negotiations were still underway with the contractor at Angel Vale estate.
 6. **To make recommendation re the Stepbridge consultation**
Recommendation
The Clerk to do an analysis of the information gathered
The Clerk to prepare some options of play equipment for a further consultation
The consultation to take place during the summer holidays
The Clerk to get costings & possible dates from a play provider to support the consultation
 7. **To make recommendation re resident concern at Sylvan Close play area**
After much discussion it was determined that the Council could offer no solution to the resident's problem
Recommendation
The Clerk to inform the resident
 8. **To make recommendation re the request for a play area at the Queens Way Estate**
Recommendation
The Clerk to contact 2 Rivers Housing to request that they work with their tenants in creating a residents association which would ascertain if it is the community's wish for a play area
 9. **To make recommendation re the phone boxes consultation**
Recommendation
That a further consultation is held with posters & flyers in the phone boxes
That Redbrook PC are contacted re their proposal to turn a booth into a water fountain
The installation of defibrillator in the booth at Tufthorn is reviewed as a modern booth may be more appropriate

 10. **To commission an audit of trees in the parish**
Recommendation
That the Clerk works with Cllr M Cox to map the trees for which the Council is responsible in the parish
That the Clerk obtains quotes for the tree audit
 11. **To make recommendation an Angel Vale Estate newsletter**
Recommendation
That a letter is sent to all residents of the estate explaining the new arrangements
