5. To review 'spare capacity' within CTC Assets and recommend marketing actions

The breakdown of usage of the Council Chamber was studied. Potential areas for hire were identified

Recommendation

That the Council Chamber hire opportunities are advertised on Facebook along with photographs and rates of hire.

6. To make recommendation re budget for Christmas Switch on event

Cllr Penny presented the attached budget

The committee studied the proposal in full

Recommendation

That the proposal is implemented and the budget agreed at a maximum cost of £5500.00

7. To receive an update on WW1 planned activities for 2018

Cllr Holloway gave a summary of the events planned for next year including:

- A poppy flow from 2 sides of the Clock Tower falling hopefully into a carpet surrounding the British Legion Garden of Remembrance
- A poppy rock concert
- A Friday in June a peace party (tea party) for the children at the Angus Buchannan VC Recreation Ground in a marquee (replicating the 1919 tea party)
- Followed by a dance in the marquee on the Saturday
- The gateways to the town be seeded with poppies
- The laying of wreaths on each war grave on the date that they died.
 The Clerk noted that these meeting should be called through the CTC office and displayed on the public notice. The office would arrange for the minutes to be taken

8. To review and make recommendation regarding rebalancing the 2017/18 events budget

Cllr penny produce the attached report. Cllr Ball asked for a small sum to be retained to enable some youth engagement
