5. To make recommendation re marketing activities since the removal of the Severn Bridge tolls

There was a wide ranging debate with examples of literature produce by other towns **Recommendation**

A leaflet advertising the area with information about events, places to stay and attractions Heritage Guides are approach to produce the leaflet on the same basis as the Town Guide The new leaflet replaces the Town Guide

The leaflets are distributed to all the major conurbations in a 50 mile radius

Wye Valley & Forest of Dean Tourism association are asked to approach Bristol based bus companies for an advertising campaign on or in the buses

The TIC Co-ordinator is asked to liaise with the Bristol Tourist Centre

6. To make recommendation re the Civic Dinner

It was confirmed that the Bells Hotel had been booked for 6 April 2019 and a menu agreed. Invitations would be distributed shortly

The committee were asked for original fund raising ideas for Cllr Penny that would make him step out of his comfort zone.

7. To make recommendation re the Battle of Coleford event - 23rd February

Confirmation that this event would occur on 23 February 2019 at 11.30 am and that the Mayor would be firing a musket

- To provide a range of activities which promote tourism and visitors to the parish throughout the year.
- To work with all partners that provide facilities or events in the town, e.g. the Christmas Lights Committee, the Coleford Carnival of Transport, the Coleford Music Festival, The Coleford Area MCTi Partnership, Churches Together, and the Festival of Words,
- To promote the use of the Town Centre as an open performance space.
- To improve the activities available for all sections of the community
- To work with the outlying communities to provide events and activities outside the town centre
- To work with local businesses to provide a variety of cultural and entertaining events, e.g. St John St Traders Association

Town Marketing and Tourism

- To ensure that the town and town events are marketed to the wider surrounding area.
- To network with the Forest of Dean and Wye Valley Tourism Association to ensure that all content relating to Coleford is up to date and portrays the town in the best way possible
- To collect where possible data information about the visitors to the area.
- To monitor the performance of the Tourist Information Centre. (TIC)
- To maintain all TIC records of stock and sales
- To review TIC sales and promotion strategies.
- To promote Coleford and the wider area both locally and nationally.
- To enhance opportunities with St Hilaire de Riez, our twin town, and twinning association

Council Marketing

- To ensure that the activities of the Council are well published
- To ensure that the website is current and user friendly
- To ensure that an effective social media profile is maintained
- To produce when necessary a local newsletter
- To ensure that there are adequate and well used notice boards around the parish
- To promote all the Town Council assets

That the committee contribute to:

- the implementation of relevant aspects of CNDP, CTC1, CTC3, CE1 its review and production and implementation of the 4 year Town Council Plan
- and produce a recommended budget for the forth coming year for its account codesto be put before Finance and Office Committee at its October / November meeting.

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
