

4 Highmeadow to Welsh Mountains	Highmeadow farm area	Over AONB into Wales	Vast view of green and biodiverse landscape	Pref not developed but if small scale and agricultural/leisure then in character and with green landscaping mature trees sited specifically to preserve view
5 The edge to the north of Coleford showing bowl with town in centre, and skyline	The Gorse	Lower Lane, Broadwell	Shows the landscape setting and Green Ring	None. Should preserve skyline and setting
6. The edge to the north of Coleford showing bowl with town in centre, and skyline	Poolway Rd	The Gorse, Lower Lane	Shows the landscape setting and Green Ring	None. Should preserve skyline and setting

11 Gorsty Knoll	Milkwall, Station Road	Gorsty Knoll above loop	Green and heritage of meend	No development to conserve, but any small scale conversion extension in character, garden
12 High St to Market Place	High Nash	Market Place, Conservation Area, Clock Tower	Gateway 5 High Nash Perrygroveinto town, main route for visitors to see Clock Tower focus for old town	Design in character with Conservation Area, High St frontage and Local Green Space on roundabout by Lawnstone, FoDDC offices
